General Manager's Office

My door is always open. Please come and see me when you have a question.

My normal hours are Monday-Friday 9-4, and most Saturdays 9-Noon, no appointment necessary.



With the Memorial Day weekend many of our summer people will be coming up to open their homes for the season. With that they will want to pick up the PSCA badges, vehicle stickers, etc.

Also a lot of you haven't received your new recreation vehicles and boat stickers. So we are going to setup the distribution system we used at the end of March. With a little adjustment.

If your dues are paid and your account is up to date you can proceed to either the Office meeting room for your badges or the Security station in the main parking lot. If you need to make a payment you should proceed to the Main office window before picking up any items.



The office will be open until 7:00 PM Friday night May 24th for all those coming up early.



The office will open early Saturday. The hours of operations will be 8:00 AM thru 2:00 PM.

We ask that everyone coming to the office on Saturday, whether it is for badges or stickers, to park in the main office parking lot. Security will be setup in the main office lot to handle all the stickers for the recreation vehicles and the boat stickers.

In the office you can go to the meeting room if you are just in need of your badges. There, staff members will be able to take care of you quickly.



If you need to pay you dues, the window will be staffed to accept your payment.

All other business will also be handled at the window.

We hope by doing it this way we will keep the front gate from being backed up. We also hope that by separating the duties those who want to conduct regular business will not experience any long wait times.

Pool & Snack Bar Up Date

I am happy to report that it looks as if we will have a full compliment of Red Cross certified lifeguards.

The plan for so far is:

Open Sat 5/25 & Sun 5/26 11 AM —8 PM
Mon 5/27 11 AM — 4 PM

After that we will be open every Saturday 11 AM—8 PM and Sunday 11 AM—5 PM through June 30th. Starting July 1st we will be open every day.

I am also happy to report that we have staff to operate the Snack Bar. The days of operation will mirror the Pool operations.

Once the pool goes to seven days the Snack bar will be open rain or shine. The rain day hours will be 11AM until 3 PM. So even though you may not be able to swim you still can come down and have a hamburger or a hot dog.
